THE HARD ROAD

THE EDEN WILDTRAX IS A VAN THAT WILL GET YOU TO SOME OF THOSE MORE REMOTE PLACES WE DREAM OF. WE CUT TO THE CHASE ON WHY IT DESERVES ITS EXCELLENT REPUTATION.



hen it comes to choosing a van for a once-in-a-lifetime escape into the unknown, the list of options seem bewildering.
But when we pare back our requirements, we start to get a clearer view of what will best suit.

One place to start is how large of a van we really need – if size was unimportant, we would probably all go for the biggest available.

However, while size should be one of our primary concerns, keeping everyone happy in a more compact family van can mean compromising. The upside of downsizing is seen on the road, where the smaller the van the easier and less expensive it will be to tow.

The choices keep on piling up when we look at various construction methods. It's probably no secret that the review team at Caravan World are all drawn to vans with both modern components and technology. This favouritism especially comes into play when the van is destined for a hard life on hard roads to distant destinations.

While every build method has advantages, the stars align here for a strongly-engineered aluminium frame on a robust chassis. In offroad conditions, where wheels are riding on uneven ground, the builder needs to consider the twisting stresses on the caravan frame and body. If the frame is too stiff, there is danger it will crack. If it is too flexible, the attached furniture and cladding are in danger of falling off or cracking.

Eden Caravans address this engineering conundrum with an aluminium frame held together with hydraulic-pressed steel rivets for a body that has just the right amount of give for a lifetime of extreme use. And, according to Andrew Altschwager

I'd agree.

For practical purposes a 19ft 6in van is around the smallest we might consider for a family, so this Eden meets a lot of criteria for a practical and tough adventure van. Included are the travelling family essentials of a caravan queen bed, the choice of two or three bunks, a bathroom, and a reasonable size kitchen and a dinette. The van tips the scales with a tare of 2680kg, which is pretty reasonable considering the level of standard equipment and bulletproof design.

THE BUILD

The robust build starts with an FP chassis from Melbourne builder Frank Panella. He took the brand name from his initials when he started the business back in 2004. He now builds 1000 chassis a year for clients he says appreciate his hands-on supervision of his tight 15-strong team.


The Wildtrax chassis is built from 3mm Australian Tube Mills steel, finished in an internal and external DuraGal coating. DuraGal saves around 60kg over hot dipped galvanising and is said to give comparative protection over the life of the van. A 150mm x 50mm A-frame leads back

to a laminated chassis of two main beams 100mm x 50mm beams welded together for a stronger construction than a single 200mm x 50mm section.

The one-piece marine ply floor sits rigidly on a maze of 50mm risers supported by 100mm x 50mm crossbeams and all the electronics and plumbing are well protected close to the floor.

The baseline suspension for the Wildtrax series is Cruisemaster's very capable XT independent system with twin shock absorbers. FP build a unique Framework for the Cruisemaster with a single member supporting the shock absorber mount and the Trailing arm. It's claimed to be lighter and superbly strong. Down below, 16in alloy wheels shod with 265x75 mud terrain tyres add to the nuggety appearance and the high ride of the van.

The body of the van comprises a wall frame of 25mm interlocked aluminium C-section rivetted together with aircraft quality fastenings. Voids between the frame are filled with close fitting polystyrene insulation before an outside cladding of 3mm composite aluminium and an internal ply sheet are fixed. The roof is a single 30mm thick composite sandwich pressed panel for strength, durability, efficient insulation, and weather protection.



THE EXTERIOR

With a colour scheme of grey and black, it's only splashes of bright blue that keep the Eden from looking too severe. True to the current vogue for offroad vans, checkerplate protection runs low along the sides and across each end.

The Wildtrax rides high and has a really powerful presence and an unmistakable offroad intent that is reinforced with a sizable black toolbox at the A-frame and a smattering of hatches along the sides. Down the back a single spare wheel sits on a high bar, while up on the roof the Houghton Belaire 3400 air conditioner adds 22cm to the overall height.

The coupling is the popular Cruisemaster DO35 for easy hitching and safe performance from the wide articulation and ADR-compliant locking mechanism. There's the obligatory brake away system but no sway control. The toolbox and a pair of 9kg gas bottles are protected by a full-width stone guard with lower Eden-branded mud flaps that should stop a lot of stone damage to the undercarriage.

Typical of the attention to detail Eden Caravans applies to their vans, a Weber Baby Q in the toolbox is colour coded to the blue on the sides. The barbecue

Moving back along the passenger side we find a full-width tunnel boot, a large picnic table, and an entertainment hatch with internal points for 240V, 12V, and TV. External speakers and good LED lighting under a full-length awning add to the outdoor relaxing vibe.

WHAT'S INSIDE?

A fold-out step is needed to scale the heights to the Eden's interior but it's worth the effort to take in the unpretentious but beautifully styled modern interior. Colour choices from the team at Caravans Coffs Coast are always spot on, and here the Graphite and Modern Concrete Black against the white walls and ceiling is simple and enduring. Sterling Silver backsplashes and nostalgic timber highlights of the Grey Bardolino benchtop and table combine for a desirable interior space.

Furniture is hand crafted for a tight fit and all cupboards have piano hinges and superior gas struts and catches. Soft-closing drawers are metal sided with positive locks.

The layout places an east-west bed forward of the entry with a central living space and the rear of the van split either side of the central walkway between a set of bunks and the ensuite. I would usually highlight an east-west bed as a potential problem for some buyers, but Eden has solved any access issues by leaving space at the foot of the bed. It's a trick I

have seen in other vans over the years, and I don't understand why it's not a more common design feature. But there is no denying that in this size van, a crossways bed is the only practical way to save space.

Another necessary compromise in a 19ft 6in van is the modest amount of kitchen bench space. The area is compact but a colour-coded timber cover over the stove helps, and the angled kitchen steals a little bit more. The high microwave isn't a favourite of mine in a family van, but it would take a smarter mind than mine to find a safer place for it. I like the full oven though, and the 224L 12V fridge is a good size for all the ravenous youngsters aboard.

While the L-shaped microfibre lounge probably won't fit a family of five, the design is thoughtful. The long table can drop to make an extra bed, and also swivels for extra prep area close to the kitchen.

A set of triple bunks down the back have their own narrow window for a view and some breeze, and each bed also has its own light, USB port, and storage nook. A built-in ladder will make access simple and a raised lip at the bed will prevent falls. At the end of the walkway a huge cupboard – even with the space taken by a 3.5kg washing machine – solves all the family's storage needs. I sometimes wonder about the worth of washers in vans but while we were having a coffee after our review, we did the sums for a family on the road for six months and concluded the washer should pay for itself within that time. They are also very handy if you have a generator and a water supply when camped off-grid.

A bathroom of a decent size is important in a family van, and this one should be popular with everyone. The roomy ensuite has good ventilation and the single piece shower has plenty of room to move.

SELF-SUFFICIENCY

The Eden is all about getting into the bush and away from the crowds and the comprehensive power package is well up to the task. Three 170W solar panels deliver a total of 510W to the 200Ah Enerdrive lithium battery through a 40A DC/DC charger. A second charger handles input from 240V.

A total of 200L of fresh water is a decent amount for long stays if it's not used for washing, but hopefully you can find a waterhole or a beach to keep fresh.

THE DRIVE

With all the equipment and robust engineering, it's no wonder tare is 2680kg. And a payload as much as 820kg will take maximum weight to the 3500kg ATM. It was an easy task for the 200 Series to handle the empty van on the winding roads out of Coffs Harbour towards Nana Glen. The ride was smooth and without vice, so the LandCruiser was a good match. We didn't overstretch the offroad capability, but given the well credentialled undercarriage, I have no doubt the Eden is up to the task of covering long stretches of rough road with confidence. Driving to the conditions is key.

WARRANTY

Structural components including the body and furniture have a three-year warranty while components are covered for one year. I'm satisfied that Caravans Coffs Coast will make sure anything that's a problem will be fixed so that the caravanning experience is nothing but pleasant.

THE WRAP

The Wildtrax will suit a family of five who want to take on some of our iconic drives and with reliable power and a comfortable retreat at the end of the day.

With the cost of components rising every week, the drive away price of the Eden 19ft 6in family van has snuck up to \$101,325. That's still good value in the context of a capable offroader with a comprehensive electronics package.




A CHECKLIST OF THE ESSENTIALS

AS ONE OF AUSTRALIA TOP TOURIST DESTINATIONS, THE RED CENTRE OFFERS A PLETHORA OF 'MUST-SEE' ATTRACTIONS, FROM WELL-KNOWN TO MORE OBSCURE.

n what used to be called 'the Mereenie Loop' – part of it goes through Mereenie Valley – The Red Centre Way is your grand tour of the best of Central Australia. It's such an integral part of our country that even high school groups head to the iconic destinations as it's a great way to feel as though you're in a different country – a different planet even

The long-haul drive is what makes the outback so special and it makes you realise how lively the desert is with its diverse landscapes and unique and native species. There are also a variety of experiences in the Red Centre that will interest you. If anything here piques your interest or you're after deals and further information, discovercentralaustralia.com.au will help you.

The best way to explore the attractions is to dot them out on a map, choose your accommodation and fuel and food refill points – things are further than they seem – make sure you have the right gear and vehicles – a 4WD and offroad vans are highly recommended – and then start. While there are certain times of the year that are best to visit, don't let that stop you, sunsets are gorgeous in the tropical summer while the hot, sunny days are perfect for swimming. Here's a list of some of the essentials to visit while you're there.

ALICE SPRINGS

Combining culture, history, and adventure, Alice Springs is an excellent place to set up base for a few days.

For adventure seekers out there, step out of your comfort zone by gliding or taking a helicopter over town, floating across the MacDonnell Ranges and Alice in a morning hot air balloon ride or hiring a mountain bike and exploring the endless trails.

For those after different sorts of joys, take a guided tour on the back of a camel, join a local guide and discover the cultural significance of the region to the Arrernte People – they're incredibly warm-hearted and knowledgeable – or take a guided tour of the night sky with a visit to the Earth Sanctuary.

Regardless of your age or type of travel, it's truly a place for everyone. Don't miss the Alice Springs Desert Park to learn about the landscape, fauna – consider booking the Nocturnal Tour – and Indigenous culture you'll see on the way.

STANDLEY CHASM/ ANGKERLE ATWATYE

Located near the West MacDonnell National Park, floodwaters cut through quartzite thousands of years ago to form a picturesque natural chasm, best seen in the middle of a sunny day – don't forget your hat and sunscreen. After a \$13 entrance fee, it's just a short walk into the Chasm. It's also a great pit stop for lunch and drinks, and, if you like, you can stop here to camp. Make sure to walk along Section 3 of Larapinta Trail for a sensational view of the front and back of the Chasm.

SERPENTINE GORGE AND CHALET

For a secluded area with an impressive lookout walk for great views across valleys, Serpentine Gorge is a lesser-known spot on this list. After rain, it has a small waterhole where you can enjoy a picturesque view, while 8km further west is Serpentine Chalet where you can base yourself to visit Ellery Creek or Ormiston Gorge. In 1958, the camp was built to help boost tourism in the area, where they did tours and even had cabins, a kitchen, and staff quarters. While the buildings are now gone, it's a great free camping spot.

ORMISTON GORGE/KWARTATUMA

This easy-to-access gorge is the most photographed gorge in the entire outback. It has a small campground (\$10pp), a kiosk, toilets, hot showers, and free gas barbecues. Other than the swimming and birdwatching afforded to you here, there are plenty of short walks. A 15-minute climb takes you to Ghost Gum Lookout, otherwise the 3-4-hour Pound Walk really shows you the beauty of this place.

GLEN HELEN GORGE

This picturesque waterhole breaks up the ranges and is a short distance away from Heritage-listed, Discovery Parks Glen Helen, formerly part of a cattle station. The landscape here is spectacular, with a towering sandstone backdrop, as well as views of Mount Sonder, one of the highest points in Central

Australia. Nature and wildlife lovers will enjoy the fish species in the Finke River here and the migrating waterbirds. If photography or art is your passion, take a few snaps or open your sketchbook; there's plenty to take in

MOUNT SONDER LOOKOUT

Just after you cross the Finke River, the world's oldest river, take the turnoff to the lookout on your right. After a short, steep hill, you'll be able to see grand views of the Finke, Two Mile and MacDonnell Ranges, with Rwetyepme/Mount Sonder on the skyline. It's a great spot to view a sunrise or sunset, especially with the unpolluted skies and climate.

REDBANK GORGE/YARRETYEKE

As a western gorge in the West MacDonnell Ranges at the base of Mount Sonder, this mixes adventure and bush camping (\$5pp). It's a permanent waterhole of cultural significance to the Western Arrernte people and is a refuge for plants and animals. Like all these locations, you feel the natural magic of the landscape as you walk down to the gorge which takes about 20 minutes. This is where those hiking the Larapinta Trail – one of the most popular bushwalks in Central Australia – from the west, start. In the summer it's a lovely swimming location, and when there's enough water, you can take a floating device like a tyre tube and float along – the water can be pretty cold though!

GOSSE BLUFF/TNORALA

This massive comet crater dominating the landscape is accessible with 4WDs only. The rough and rocky 5km track takes you inside the crater, with the area a registered sacred site. The Traditional Owners – the Malbunka family – and NT Parks and Wildlife have built walking tracks and other infrastructure inside the crater and ask that the area is respected. The crater seen today is about 2km lower than the original impact surface, now only about 5km in diameter compared to its original 20km.



KINGS CANYON

Located in Watarrka National Park, this ancient red canyon soars 100m above Kings Creek to a plateau of rocky domes. Take in the views of the desert and palms below – and nestled into the crevices – and feel as though you're on top of the world as you walk along the cliffs. The canyon is perfect for lovers of hiking, wildlife spotting, and of course photography, and all these can be done through ranger-guided activities. Take the 6km Rim Walk down into the Garden of Eden before ascending up stairs to 360-degree panoramic views. The canyon is of great importance to the Luritja and Arrente People who ask that you do not swim in the waters, but you're free to climb, touch, and explore the canyon in a respectful manner.

MOUNT CONNOR/ATILA

Locally called 'Fool-uru' due to people thinking it's Uluru, this is a sacred site for Indigenous men, located on Curtain Springs Station. You can only visit via booking a tour, such as a SEIT tour, and there is a great lookout and roadside rest area nearby, as well as another viewing area on the dune lookout on the opposite side of the road. You can also view the Lake Amadeus salt plains near the Mount Connor lookout.

ULURU

Yulara is a great place to stop and set up before heading off to Uluru. It's a town where you can refuel and stock up on supplies and even send some mail and get a haircut. Once inside Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, you cannot camp anywhere except at the Ayers Rock Resort's campground. View the sunrise or sunset at one of the multiple viewing areas and watch the rainbow of colours change as they hit Uluru, the 348m high and 550-million-year-old rock. Take the Base Walk, the Mala Walk – a guided tour from rangers – a camel tour or bike ride around for an up close and personal experience. To understand the significance of Uluru, make sure your listen to

the local Anangu people as they tell stories of the Dreamtime. Learning about those who shape the Northern Territory will leave you with more than just a photo.

KATA TJUTA

While a bit challenging, one of the best ways of exploring Kata Tjuta is by taking the Valley of the Winds walk. Here, you hike 7.4km around and through the soaring rock domes as they change colour during the day. Also located in Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, there are a number of varying

levels of tracks you can take, and a short walk to the Kata Tjuta dune viewing area gives you some breathtaking panoramic views. The park is a UNESCO World Heritage Area for both its natural and cultural values and is jointly managed by the Anangu people and Parks Australia.

What makes the Red Centre so easily accessible is that there are plenty of free camping spots to immerse yourself in nature along the way, from the Hugh River to Point Howard to Two Mile to Ginty's Lookout. As long as you have the right vehicle and permits, the Red Centre is a must visit for Australians after adventure after the lockdowns we've had, particularly for those who usually head overseas.

A long-haul drive to Alice Springs and the surrounding regions could be an excellent way to cure post-lockdown blues, and to help rejuvenate communities that rely on tourism. Make sure to tag @visitcentralaus when out there to show others the amazing places you've visited. For more info or to start planning, check out discovercentralaustralia.

One thing's for certain though – you'll leave the Red Centre feeling much better. The fresh air and isolation does wonders, so get out there.





ometimes you just want to climb into bed after some tough travelling. With the right rig, you'll have your bed set up, a place out of the rain and access to all your gear, all in a couple of minutes. If you are staying longer than overnight, another easy few minutes will see you have more undercover area on the other side of the trailer and the kitchen.

THE BUILD AND DESIGN

Quality components add up to a quality build - simple as that. This is a fully Aussie made trailer from south east Queensland on a purpose-built hot-dipped galvanised chassis which has the Cruisemaster suspension bolted on. Air bag or coil suspension is your choice. The six storage compartments are CAD designed and fit together to give you over 2000L of storage space that is easily accessible.

The rooftop tent is from Crazy Dog Canvas in Hervey Bay – I purchased a similar tent from Jason at Crazy Dog a few years ago so I know it well. The canvas is of course quality Aussie canvas and the workmanship is second to none. One of the best design features is that when the tent is set up, the awning is part of the tent so that not only do you get a bed, but you also get an undercover area the length of the tent. This is invaluable if it's raining. I say this from experience in Tassie where it rained four out of five days for a month.

LIVEABILITY

Often small trailers don't have quite enough storage space, but the EXCEED counters this in the form of six large and easily accessible compartments. This means it will be easy to find what you are looking for as items like tables and chairs can be stored separately

to clothes and food. The separate L-shaped awning is also quick and easy to set up as it is free-standing, although it's best to tie it down in windy weather. This awning covers one whole side of the trailer (and more) as well as the pullout kitchen at the rear. The beauty of an awning on this side means you will always be able to find shade or a place out of the rain – even with a bit of a gale blowing.

The pullout kitchen has a return that gives plenty of preparation area and a shelf to store food and cooking items. Kids will be able to access this without coming into the kitchen area. There is space for a stove if you already have one or it can be supplied. Water is plumbed so it is available next to the stove. The fridge is an upright 65L one that is accessible whether the kitchen is out or not.





loody hell, that Bimmer is good." enthused Tim van Duyl, after stepping out from behind the wheel of the BMW X5 xDrive 30d, fresh from a 600km towing stint. Days earlier we'd been debating the towing credentials of the German luxury SUV, specifically whether it had the goods to mix it with the likes of LandCruiser, Patrol and others. We agreed that, while it would probably drive better than just about anything else on the market, it may not have the requisite grunt and towing stability to handle mid-to heavy-duty haulage. Now, having returned from a two-day jaunt towing a 21-footer to Victoria's Otways and back, we had the answer.

WHAT'S IT ALL ABOUT?

The BMW X5 is one of Australia's most popular large-premium SUVs, notching up just under 3000 sales as at the end of November 2021, meaning it's bettered only in its category by the Mercedes-Benz GLE-Class wagon. With a recommended retail price of \$121,900, this X5 xDrive 30d model sits just above the entry level xDrive 25d (\$104,900), the latter packing a smaller 2L turbodiesel engine versus the 30d's 3L six-cylinder. Between them the xDrive 25d and 30d make up the entirety of the diesel offering in the seven model X5 range, with other variants equipped with either an inline 3L petrol six-cylinder turbo, or a

4.4L twin turbo petrol V8. At the top of the X5 family tree sits the X5 M Competition, with its eye-watering \$212,900 price tag and bristling 460kW/750Nm outputs from a thunderous twin turbo V8 – although BMW makes no claims about this variant's towing credentials

This last fact would barely raise an eyelid usually, given that BMWs have long been known for their performance, luxury fit out and dynamic handling abilities, but far less commonly for their ability to haul a load. That all changed in late 2019, however, when the German car maker began offering a factorydesigned and installed towing system for several of its X5, and larger X7 SUV models.

The factory towing hitch requires no removal of parts, ensuring seamless vehicle integration, according to BMW, and comes with a specific multifunction control unit that offers an additional zoom function for the rear camera, as well as a trailer stabilisation system. At a cost of \$2500 fitted, the tow hitch is rated at 2700-3500kg braked, depending on the model, and comes with an integrated hitch receiver, bespoke control unit and specific vehicle wiring harness. BMW says its Australian dealers can supply and fit an approved tongue kit and adapter wiring harness, at a cost of \$700 including GST.

Thus equipped, the X5 xDrive 30d rolls out of the showroom with a 3500kg braked towing capacity and a 280kg maximum down ball load, which we

figured would be a reasonable complement for the Jayco Silverline 21ft Touring caravan we had back at the office. The 2.47m wide, by 2.95m tall Silverline has a travel length of 8m and weighs in at 2500kg empty, with an ATM of 3000kg. That's safely within the X5's braked tow capacity and it's worth noting that, with the BMW's 750kg payload and utilising its full 280kg tow ball rating, there's still a healthy 470kg of payload remaining.

INSIDE OUT

This latest version of the X5, codenamed G05, is the fourth generation of the BMW SUV and launched here in 2018. It's longer, wider, more powerful, and

more hi-tech than the model it replaced, but there's nonetheless something reassuringly familiar about its wedge-like profile.

With clean, strong lines and well-balanced proportions, the X5 looks muscular and assertive but not so large as to be intimidating in tight car parks. Its short front and rear overhangs merge into a stylish character line that runs from behind the front wheel arch, through the centre of the door handles, all the way to the rear, where it kicks up over powerful haunches. The famous BMW kidney grille has never looked bigger or bolder and is finished in a classy satin alloy, creating a powerful, angular graphic that's flanked by the standard LED headlights and large cooling intake ducts.

After being left behind in the interior design stakes by rivals Audi and Mercedes-Benz for a few years there, BMW has moved away from its somewhat austere interior style to something notably more luxurious. A 12.3in high-resolution colour display dominates the centre fascia, its functionality underpinned by the quick and efficient BMW Operating System 7.0. There's another identically sized screen in front of the driver, housing a crisply rendered and configurable digital instrument display.

The various buttons and controls have all been nicely simplified into a clean and elegant interface, with BMW's intuitive Live Cockpit Professional system ensuring the various systems can be controlled via touchscreen, the iDrive rotary Touch Controller, Gesture Control, or voice activation.

You sit up high on excellent sports front seats that are electrically operated and trimmed in supple and aromatic 'Vernasca' leather, with a commanding view out over the road and good all-around visibility. The interior is light and airy, thanks in large part to the sizeable panoramic sunroof, which it should be noted may become a liability in hotter climates.



The rear pews offer good space for two large adults or three kids, with generous head and legroom, plus individual climate controls for passengers and twin USB charge points in the front-row seat backrests, which are also designed to include tablet mounts.

The sizeable 645L boot can be expanded to 1860L with the second row folded, with the two-piece electric tailgate offering hands-free opening by waving a foot under the rear bumper.

WHAT'S IN THE KIT?

Luxury car makers competing in this market have long known that Aussies like their prestige vehicles highly specified, hence why BMW offers the X5 xDrive 30d exclusively with its so-called M Sport Package. The latter includes a range of tasty extras that enhance the already generous equipment package of the entry level xDrive 25d.

The extras include M Sport brakes with blue painted M-branded calipers, Adaptive M Suspension with selectable Comfort and Sport modes, stitched 'Vernasca' leather upholstery, electrically operated sports front seats, M branded door sill finishers, aluminium mesh effect interior trim, M leather steering wheel, 20-inch M light alloy wheels, panoramic glass sunroof, and M roof rails.

Other standard features of the X5 30d include adaptive LED headlights, LED fog lights, ambient interior lighting, dual zone climate control, parking assistant Plus, 360-degree cameras, head up display, comfort access system, DAB+ digital radio, an excellent 10-speaker 205W audio system, hill descent control, and wireless smartphone charging, to name just a few.

As with most prestige models there are ample options to choose from, some of which BMW has handily bundled into the xOffroad Package (\$6307) and the Indulgence Package (\$6001). The former is likely to be of most interest to caravanners, as it includes additional aluminium underbody protection and a self-levelling pneumatic suspension setup that can be adjusted to five different ride height levels, with a total sweep of 80mm (40mm higher or lower than standard height).

On the safety front, in addition to the expected plethora of front, side and full-length curtain airbags, there's a bristling armoury of the latest active safety features, including Active Cruise Control with Stop & Go function, front and rear Cross traffic warning, Steering and Lane Control Assistant, Lane keeping Assistant with Side Collision and Crossroads warning, and Evasion Aid.

Naturally, there's also a range of driving stability systems including Dynamic Stability Control, ABS and DTC (Dynamic Traction Control), CBC (Cornering Brake Control), DBC (Dynamic Brake Control), Fading Compensation, Start-Off Assistant, ADB-X (Active Differential Brake), HDC (Hill Descent Control), and Dynamic Damper Control.

THRIFTY SIPPER

Among the reasons for Tim's resounding endorsement of the X5 after this test was the smooth and gutsy performance of the turbocharged 3L inline sixcylinder diesel, and its impressive fuel-efficiency. It's undoubtedly one of the best drivetrains we've driven to date, and comes wrapped in that handsome metal skin and cosseting interior.

Featuring a variable inlet geometry turbo and common rail direct injection the engine delivers remarkably crisp response, as well as strong

performance and efficiency. Outputs of 195kW/620Nm are channelled through an excellent eight-speed ZF auto and on-demand all-wheel drive system, a combination that propels the unladen X5 from 0-100km/h in a brisk 6.5 seconds.

It's not just the unladen performance that impresses, either, because we can't recall driving anything this side of a RAM that pulled as hard up a freeway on-ramp, the silky inline six swiftly getting into the meat of its torque curve, the big Bimmer piling on the pace from 40 to 100km/h as the auto seamlessly served up the cogs.

Of course, this sort of performance usually comes at a cost at the bowser but over the course of our towing loop we saw average fuel consumption of 13.8L/100km. That's not bad, but more so when you consider that it included numerous stop-start short runs where we were accelerating from standstill for the video cameras, and a more aggressive drive up and through the Otways than the average tourer would contemplate. Perhaps the more accurate metric is the X5's indicated freeway towing figure, which at a constant 100km/h was a very respectable 12L/100km.

Climbing up from scenic Apollo Bay into the dense eucalypt-clad ranges of Victoria's Great Otways National Park, the auto transmission's manual mode and steering wheel mounted paddles added an extra level of control, allowing the driver to manually hold a gear for extra braking when rolling into a corner, or when ascending and descending the area's many hills.

Other towing-related features we liked were the trailer sway control, and Tow Mode function, the latter coming on automatically when a hitch is inserted. We also appreciated the sure-footed stopping power of the four-wheel disc brakes, while the HD cameras with 360-degree and 'zoom' tow mode were excellent when hitching and unhitching the caravan.

On the flip side, the autonomous emergency braking system, which admittedly plays a vital role in the X5's comprehensive safety armoury, was a real pain in the rear when reversing to hitch up, as it kept kicking in and stopping the vehicle, even when in Tow Mode. It's no great inconvenience, but had to be disabled each time the caravan needed to be reversed.



THE WRAP UP

Tallying up the ledger at the end of this test we find many more ticks on the positive side of the ledger than the alternative, including impressive fuel efficiency, the smooth and super responsive engine with its muscular 620Nm of torque, and the slick shifting eight-speed auto.

The driving position is excellent, too, with the electrically adjusted seats offering a wide range of adjustment, and a driving position memory function that ensures swapping drivers doesn't require endless readjustment. There are many other little details that add to the overall enjoyment of the X5, including its terrific in-car entertainment system that connects phones seamlessly, the operating system's lightning-quick response to commands, and the practical and easy to live with interior layout and design.

The lows are fewer but worth noting, including of course the price, which at an estimated driveaway in Victoria of \$136k is hardly cheap motoring, and enough to fund both the Silverline and an Isuzu MU-X, should you choose a more budget-friendly approach. That said, the latest LandCruiser 300 Series Sahara ZX is slightly more expensive again, so it's not like the X5's pricing is off in the stratosphere.

We'd also have to say that despite the X5's impressive performance with 2500kg in tow, we aren't entirely convinced that it will be up to task of hauling the full 3500kg it's rated for, mainly on the basis that at 2100kg QUICK SPECS

the vehicle feels relatively light. The lowish GCM figure of 6360kg will also limit the X5's overall capability when hitching up to bigger vans.

Despite these criticisms, our overall impression of the X5 as a luxury tow companion is overwhelmingly favourable, and we'd have no hesitation recommending it to anyone towing up to around that 2500kg mark, or a bit beyond. In fact, so impressed were we with the German wunderkind that it now has us pondering what the larger BMW X7 and respective rivals from Mercedes-Benz and Audi might be like in the crucible of a Caravan World tow test. Based on what we've seen with the X5, the Germans might yet spring a few surprises.

Above Overall, with its extra towing-related features, the X5 is an excellent choice



EXPLORE ONE OF THE MOST SPECTACULAR GORGES HIDDEN WITHIN QUEENSLAND'S CARNARVON NATIONAL PARK

AND PICS GLENN MARSHALL


n oasis in the heart of Central Queensland, towering white sandstone cliffs form a breathtaking gorge carved by Carnarvon Creek over millions of years. With narrow gorges feeding off the main gorge containing splendid attractions, remnant rainforest and a significant cultural heritage Carnarvon Gorge is the jewel in the crown in this section of the sandstone belt.

Carnarvon fan palms and ancient cycads, ferns and gum trees line the sides of the gorge while grassy open forest tops the tablelands above. The road into Carnarvon National Park will leave you awestruck as rugged cliffs dominate the skyline.

TAKING THE SCENIC ROUTE


I awoke to rain falling on my rooftop tent – the predictions had eventuated. Breaking camp was quick as a result, there wasn't even time for coffee. The tracks out of Mount Moffatt were already wet and slippery, as was Westgrove Road. It was comforting to finally reach Injune, where hot coffee and a freshly toasted sandwich were a reward.

Injune is also a good spot to fuel up, with prices reasonable for a little town. You will also have mobile

reception so allow time to update family members, check-in on Facebook and check your emails.


Driving the Carnarvon Development Road north from Injune, I was amazed by the scenery around me. Moore's cycad (Macrozamia moorei) and Carnarvon fan palms (Livistona nitida) were dotted amongst the blue gum and silver-leaved ironbark while massive sandstone cliffs dominated the skyline.

TAKARAKKA BOUND

The road into Carnarvon Gorge is bitumen all the way, different to my first visit here in 1975 when it was a dry, dusty and corrugated track – harsh on the EJ Holden's suspension and the passengers within the cab. Seatbelts weren't compulsory back then, so us kids were thrown around a bit.

Just after you cross Carnarvon Creek for the first time, there is a memorial for the Australian and American Army and Air Force personnel who were killed when their C47B Dakota aircraft crashed. The plane was flying from Darwin to Brisbane and hit a violent electrical storm on 16th November 1943 – the crash killed all 18 men onboard.

Checking into the Takarakka Bush Resort was a breeze – booking well in advance is a must as this place is packed out often, even more so during school holidays. The hot shower was refreshing after a few days of bush camping.

An information session was held outside reception where one of the resort staff described the ins and outs of Takarakka and provided advice on how best to spend one's time at Carnarvon Gorge. She also showed us a sick baby sugar glider that was hiding in her bra as it was nursed back to health. You may be amused to learn that you can spot echidnas in the platypus section and possibly spy platypus in the echidna section of the resort. Emphasis was placed on not feeding the wildlife.


FOLLOWING UP ON A LEAD

It's nice to be given a 'good tip' on a gorge that you might have missed out on if it wasn't for such great staff at Takarakka.

Having received a map of the area when checking in, I was keen to tackle something that afternoon. Mickey Creek walk was the suggestion and then the good tip was to take the right-hand trail at the Y-junction.

This walking trail takes you up along Warrumbah Creek below the bluff and it's a 3km return walk to where the formed track ends. From there you rockhop and duck amid the ferns but then the track closes in and for many, this is where you turn around and return to your vehicles. For the more adventurous and agile, you can continue up the gorge for what seems like an eternity.

This is a popular walk for families with kids of all ages, and you'll often hear the words "Come on Grandma, it's awesome up here!" The track isn't marked as such, but there is only one way in and it's the same way out. Take a water bottle and a camera as it is a thirsty walk – take your time and snap some wicked shots.



EXPLORING THE JEWELS

The next morning, I decided to challenge myself and walk the lower gorge, taking in the 'Big Four' consisting of Ward's Canyon, the Art Gallery, Amphitheatre and Moss Gardens. Classified as a Stage 3 walk, allow at least four hours to cover the 15km return walk. The track is well marked with signs indicating each turn-off, distance to the site and how far you are from the Visitor Centre.

I followed the advice from the information session and departed the Carnarvon Visitor Centre by 8am, heading to the furthest site (Ward's Canyon) before making my way back via the other sites. This provides the best light for photos, and you will beat the crowds by an hour or two. I would also suggest that you head for the Art Gallery first, as you will beat the sun shining on the best art and capture the best photographs.

A spiritual place for the Bidjara and Karingbal people, the Art Gallery was used as a meeting place between different clans in the region and was also a significant trading point. It is also one of the best examples of stencil art in Australia. The engraved Rainbow Serpent tells the story of creation and birth whilst the freehand nets indicate this was a burial site. All remains have been removed without consent and the local tribes are working at having them returned.

Ward's Canyon was named after the Ward brothers who used to trap possums for their pelts in the canyon in the early 1900s. Now it is dominated by rare and ancient King Ferns that flourish in the moist conditions alongside tall tree ferns. Access is via steps up a short steep climb, passing a small waterfall as you go.

The Amphitheatre left me awestruck. A towering chamber with an acoustic resonance hidden in the gorge, a steep set of steps needs to be scaled to reach the crack in the rock and to access this spiritual place.

The local Indigenous people used this chamber as a place for relaxation and reflection.

The Moss Garden has to be seen to be believed – a peaceful place where water constantly drips from the sandstone walls of the canyon onto beds of lush green mosses, ferns and liverworts. The trickle of water from the small waterfall adds to the serenity. It would be a rare privilege to be the only person in the garden and if it occurred you would reach a state of Zen very easily. It is also a popular lunch stop on the walk, but please take all your rubbish with you when you leave.

I was exhausted as I walked across Carnarvon Creek for the final time and I enjoyed cooling down as I had a good look around the air-conditioned and informative Visitor Centre. An ice-cold beverage that quenched my thirst when I reached my vehicle was the perfect ending.

As I spent that evening around the communal fire with fellow adventurers and reflected on the days walk, I decided I'd do it again in a heartbeat. It has been nearly 50 years since my first visit to Carnarvon Gorge, but it won't be long until I return.
